The Parsha KiTisa continues to describe the various utensils used in the Tabernacle. The story continues with a commandment to run a census of the Jewish people between the ages of 20 and 60. There are very few mysteries in the Bible that can equal the difficulty of understanding how a people led by God in greatness and miracles would allow themselves to be driven to constructing of the Golden Calf.
