The Torah reading of this week includes Moses' call to the
Children of Israel to acknowledge the watchword of our faith:
"Hear O Israel, the Lord is our God, the Lord is One".

Rabbi Zalman Schachter, the founder of the Renewal movement, once taught that we should meditate on these words in the following way:

We should repeat the sentence four times, the first time including in our thoughts, as we say the word "Israel", all our dear ones; and then all those whom we would like to join the community of Israel; then all those who are opposed to this creed; and finally recite these words including all of them. This is a simple meditation that we could all do when we say

the Shma Israel.
