## SHABBAT VAYECHI

<u>Jacob</u> lives the final 17 years of his <u>life in Egypt</u>. Before his passing, he asks <u>Joseph</u> to take an oath that he will <u>bury</u>him in the <u>Holy Land</u>. He blesses Joseph's two sons, <u>Manasseh</u> and <u>Ephraim</u>, elevating them to the status of his own sons as progenitors of <u>tribes</u> within the nation of Israel.

The patriarch desires to reveal the <u>end of days</u> to his children, but is <u>prevented</u> from doing so.

Jacob blesses his sons, assigning to each his role as a tribe: <u>Judah</u> will produce leaders, legislators and kings; priests will come from <u>Levi</u>, scholars from <u>Issachar</u>, seafarers from <u>Zebulun</u>, schoolteachers from <u>Simeon</u>, soldiers from <u>Gad</u>, judges from <u>Dan</u>, olive-growers from <u>Asher</u>, and so on. <u>Reuben</u> is rebuked for "confusing his father's marriage bed"; Simeon and Levi, for the massacre of Shechem and the plot against Joseph. <u>Naphtali</u> is granted the swiftness of a deer, <u>Benjamin</u> the ferociousness of a wolf, and Joseph is blessed with <u>beauty</u> and <u>fertility</u>.

A large funeral procession consisting of Jacob's descendants, Pharaoh's ministers, the leading citizens of Egypt and the Egyptian cavalry accompanies Jacob on his final journey to the Holy Land, where he is <u>buried</u> in the Machpelah Cave in <u>Hebron</u>.

<u>Joseph</u>, too, dies in Egypt, at the age of 110. He, too, instructs that his <u>bones</u> be taken out of Egypt and buried in the Holy Land, but this would come to pass only with the Israelites' exodus from Egypt many years later. Before his passing, Joseph conveys to the Children of Israel the testament from which they will draw their hope and faith in the difficult years to come: "G-d will surely <u>remember</u> you, and bring you up out of this land to the land of which He swore to <u>Abraham</u>, <u>Isaac</u> and <u>Jacob</u>."
