The Qur'an on Jews

[2.40] O children of Israel! Call to mind My favor which I bestowed on you and be faithful to (your) covenant with Me, I will fulfill (My) covenant with you, of Me, Me alone, should you be afraid.

[2.47] O children of Israel! Call to mind My favor which I bestowed on you and that I made you excel the nations.

[2.62] Surely those who believe, and those who are Jews, and the Christians, and the Sabians, whoever believes in Allah and the Last day and does good, they shall have their reward from their Lord, and there is no fear for he, nor shall they grieve.

[5:21] Moses said to his people: O my people! Remember the bounty of God upon you when He bestowed prophets upon you, and made you kings and gave you that which had not been given to anyone before you amongst the nations. O my people! Enter the Holy Land which God has written for you, and do no turn tail, otherwise you will be losers.

[17.104] And We said to the Israelites after him: Dwell in the land : and when the promise of the next life shall come to pass, we will bring you both together in judgment.

[3:56] But to those who reject faith (Islam) I will punish them with terrible agony in this world and in the Hereafter, nor will they have anyone to help.
