Since we have lowered the cost of an Oneg or a Kiddush, we have had more people inquiring about a date. Consider having one or the other to celebrate a special occasion.


The search committee has been actively seeking a new rabbi. If you happen to know a rabbi or cantor that wishes to have a part time position, I would appreciate if you would please let me know.
