

### **SHABBAT TETZAVEH**

G-d tells <u>Moses</u> to receive from the children of Israel pure <u>olive oil</u> to feed the "<u>everlasting flame</u>" of the menorah, which <u>Aaron</u> is to kindle each day, "from <u>evening till morning</u>."

The priestly <u>garments</u>, to be worn by the *kohanim* (priests) while serving in the <u>Sanctuary</u>, are described. All *kohanim* wore: 1) the *ketonet*—a <u>full-length</u> linen tunic; 2) *michnasayim*—linen breeches; 3) *mitznefet* or *migba'at*—a linen turban; 4) *avnet*—a long sash wound above the waist.

In addition, the <u>kohen gadol</u> (high priest) wore: 5) the *efod*—an apron-like garment made of blue-, purpleand red-dyed wool, linen and gold thread; 6) the *choshen*—a breastplate containing twelve precious stones inscribed with the names of the <u>twelve tribes</u> of Israel; 7) the *me'il*—a cloak of blue wool, with gold bells and decorative pomegranates on its <u>hem</u>; 8) the *tzitz*—a golden plate <u>worn on the forehead</u>, bearing the inscription "Holy to G-d."

Tetzaveh also includes G-d's detailed instructions for the seven-day initiation of Aaron and his four sons— <u>Nadav</u>, Avihu, Elazar and Itamar—into the priesthood, and for the making of the <u>golden altar</u>, on which the *ketoret* (incense) was burned.
