



Become the Liberator

Perhaps no story in all of the Bible has had so much influence on humanity as the story of the Exodus. It is the foundational story of the Jewish people who have survived millenia of tragedies and atrocities. Through it all, the Jewish people have always held out the hope that redemption, having come once, is bound to happen again. But it is not only the Jews who have pointed to this story as the source of faith that G-d has the power to rescue them from unspeakable horrors.

The African-American slaves in colonial America prayed for their own Moses to lead them out of slavery: "Go down, Moses, way down in Egypt's land. Tell old Pharaoh to let my people go," they sang in the familiar spiritual. Much later, Rev. Martin Luther King, Jr., used the story of Exodus to encourage those fighting for civil rights. Just as the children of Israel had to suffer many trials and tribulations in the wilderness before reaching the Promised Land, so those who were fighting for the rights of African-Americans in the 20th century, needed to have faith that their struggles were leading to an eventual promised land of freedom and justice in the U.S.

Freedom fighters in South American countries sought to overthrow oppressive dictators through the espousal of liberation theology, which insists that G-d holds a special love for those who are poor and downtrodden, as evidenced by the events of the Exodus among other biblical proofs.

The fight for freedom in our day and age has for many taken on individual and personal meaning, as we ask ourselves the questions, what enslaves us, and what do we need to do in the future to gain our own liberation? These kind of conversations can make for very lively and spirited Passover seders.

But at its core, the story of liberation from ancient *Mitzrayim*, Egypt, has to remind us to have empathy with others who are oppressed. Thirty-six times the Torah tells us in different forms: "Do not oppress the stranger, for you were strangers in the Land of Egypt." The memory of our own national trauma, MUST lead us to empathy for others who are hurting and struggling.


This year, please do one action or activity to help those who are suffering, from brutal governments, from hunger and/or homelessness, from dangerous addictions, from depression or mental illness. Reach out and be the "outstretched hand of G-d," to someone in need and make your Pesach and their lives that much more liberating.

One of the four biblical names of Pesach is "*z'man cheyruteynu* - the time of our freedom." Let us work together as a community to make greater freedom a reality of our time, and not just of our history.





Jewish Family and Children's Service (JFCS)

Ellie Schwartzberg of Jewish Family and Children's Service (JFCS) offers individual counseling, referral to appropriate resources and advocacy to Jewish people living in the Sun Cities and surrounding communities.

This is a free program underwritten by the Jewish Federation. Ellie has a Master's degree in counseling from ASU and has been at JFCS for the past 32 years working with an older population. She is currently the Vice President of Geriatric Services at JFCS. Ellie offers this program at the Sun Cities Community Services Building on Tuesdays (9451 N. 99th Ave. Sun City) and at Beth Emeth Synagogue (13702 W. Meeker, Sun

City West) on Thursdays. Counseling addresses such issues as coping with bereavement and loss, caregiving stress, long term planning and decision making, adjustment to chronic health problems, loss of independence, depression, couples' issues, communication and problem solving with adult children, etc.

Ellie facilitates a Bereavement Support Group at Beth Emeth Congregation every Thursday from 1:00-2:00 PM. This group is open to anyone who has lost a spouse or significant other within the past two years.


