

New Summer Study Series

Shalom friends,

I hope you enjoyed a wonderful Pesach. We sure did. At this time of the year, most synagogues are busy planning for the coming programming year, and winding down activities before summer. While we certainly miss the extra energy that our partial year residents bring to our shul family while they are here in the cooler months, we still have many, many folks who are year-round residents, and I thought it would be nice to offer a new opportunity for our community of learners. So this year, we will be adding a summer study series during May-June and again in August-September before our regular programming year kicks off after Sukkot.

The class will take selected Torah stories and proceed verse by verse to closely read the text, and then analyze difficulties by reading (in English translation) the comments of the famous medieval commentators: Rashi, Ramban, Ibn Ezra, and others. One story may take many weeks to unpack. Our first story will deal with the binding of Isaac. We began this text in a class I taught in January, and it was an overwhelming success.

I hope you will make time in your busy schedule to join us for some relaxed summertime learning.





Poway 2019

Once again, hatred and terror rear their ugly heads and turn them toward the Jewish people. I found out about the shooting at the Chabad of Poway when my friend, Azra Hussein, head of the Islamic Speakers Bureau of Arizona texted on Saturday afternoon: "Yet another attack on innocent Jewish families in their place of sanctuary. My heart is with all of your community." In the aftermath of the murders in the mosques of Christchurch, New Zealand, and the bombings of churches in Sri Lanka, and of course the deaths last fall at the Tree of Life synagogue in Pittsburgh, we realize that all faith traditions are vulnerable to the unjustified and irrational hatred that is perpetrated by extremists who do.

We extend our hearts and our condolences to the entire Jewish community of Poway, and especially to our neighbor, Rabbi Shelly Moss, who lived in that community for 30 years, and has known Rabbi Goldstein since he arrived in Poway, and who returned there in solidarity for the community's Yom Hashoah observance this week.

We offer our prayer for all of the Jewish people: Adonai oz l'amo yeeteyn, Adonai y'varech et amo vashalom. May God grant strength to our people, and bless us all with peace.





Counseling addresses such issues as coping with bereavement and loss, caregiving stress, long term planning and decision making, adjustment to chronic health problems, loss of independence, depression, couples' issues, communication and problem solving with adult children, etc.
- Ellie facilitates a Bereavement Support Group at Beth Emeth Congregation every Thursday from 1:00-2:00 PM. This group is open to anyone who has lost a spouse or significant other within the past two years.

NEW SUMMER STUDY SERIES


