#### FROM THE DESK OF RABBI TRACEE ROSEN

My best friend, Joy, lost her father, Marshall, this past year. Among the most important people in his life, was Mike. Mike was a younger retiree in his early 70s. He had met Marshall through a JFCS program of friendly visitors. Once a month, Mike & Marshall would get together for lunch or coffee, and once a year, when the Boston Red Sox were playing against Cincinnati at home, Mike would drive Marshall the 2 hours south from Columbus to enjoy an outing with their beloved Bo Sox. Over their 9 year relationship, Mike became an extended part of the family, included in all the family simchas.

Making friends in our older years can sometimes be very easy, especially in communities like ours where most everyone is a retiree from somewhere else. But sometimes, as our initial social group begins to diminish, from disability, limited mobility, and losing our circle of friends, we start to feel more isolated, and feel like isolating ourselves. But that's dangerous thinking.

Health care professionals and scientists are now telling us that loneliness is the greatest health epidemic in the modern world today. The British government last year appointed a Minister of Loneliness to address these issues in its country. People are going weeks and months without contact with friends or family.

We, at Beth Emeth, need to do our part for our community.

On Erev Rosh Hashanah this year, I issued a challenge to those present. Using index cards with people's names & contact information, I asked each person present to talk with someone they didn't know or didn't know well, to exchange information, and to meet up at some point between Rosh Hashanah & Yom Kippur. The idea was to stress that as human beings, we crave connection, and that sometimes we have to go out of our natural comfort zones to discover new friends who are right in front of us. If you participated in this and have any feedback, I would love to hear from you. So far, I have heard very positive responses.

Let's take this a step further. If you weren't there or didn't have a chance to reach out to someone new, it's not too late. I have contact cards in my office of members & guests. I would especially like to encourage folks to reach out to some of our members who have physical limitations which have been preventing them from participating in services and other shul activities. Please come by the office or contact me personally, and we'll help you make a friendly connection. Let's make this year of 5780 and good year, a year where we all feel more connected to one another.





Counseling addresses such issues as coping with bereavement and loss, caregiving stress, long term planning and decision making, adjustment to chronic health problems, loss of independence, depression, couples' issues, communication and problem solving with adult children, etc.
- Ellie facilitates a Bereavement Support Group at Beth Emeth Congregation every Thursday from 1:00-2:00 PM. This group is open to anyone who has lost a spouse or significant other within the past two years.
