

We Jews make a big deal about the fact that we rush to bury our dead. The practice in Israel especially can be astounding. People have died abroad and are flown back to Israel right away. The body is met by the chevrah kaddisha at the airport and driven straight to the cemetery where the family is waiting and the service is done, often under bright lights in the idle of the night. So it is amusing to me that after rushing to bury our dead bodies we spend the rest of our lives making sure the rest of the person is never buried.

As soon as we return from the cemetery, we begin 7 days of talking about the deceased and in so doing we keep them alive in our hearts. For the first 11 months after a parent dies we attend the shule daily for our scheduled meeting with them as we say kaddish in their honor. Four times a year we light a candle at home and go to shule with our community so we can all connect with our loved ones in an official and communal way as we say Yizkor. Once a year in a very personal way on the anniversary of their death we light a candle and go to shul to be with them on their day.

Every act of remembrance is a reminder that to us they are not buried. This Thursday is the next Yizkor, and though we can't say kaddish without a minyan there is no reason we should not all say Yizkor for them alone in our homes. Indeed this may be the most powerful Yizkor ever because death is all around us and we need to remind and be reminded that even after death and burial, only the body is buried, the rest of our loved ones are still with us as we remember them.
