She has studied and performed in Vancouver, Toronto, Seattle, London England, and San Diego. She has worked with international light opera and musical theater ensembles, including San Diego Opera, Vancouver Opera, Cirque Dinner Theater in Seattle, San Diego Starlight Theater and Vancouver's Theater Under the Stars.

Judith's repertoire extends from opera to folk music, spans eight languages and includes both religious and secular works. As a cantor, she maintains a comprehensive knowledge of Jewish worship services; as an opera singer, she brings passion and vocal virtuosity to her singing.
