Moses instructs the Israelites on the rituals they must perform upon entering the Promised Land. First, they must bring the first fruits of their harvest to the Temple. While presenting them, each person recites a declaration recalling their history: from Jacob's wandering to Egyptian slavery, followed by God's miraculous rescue into a land flowing with milk and honey. Next, Moses details the third-year tithe, ensuring the Levite, stranger, orphan, and widow are cared for, while affirming complete obedience to God's commandments. Finally, Moses and the elders command the people to maintain a sacred covenant. Upon crossing the Jordan River, they must set up large stones covered in plaster, write the Torah clearly upon them, and build an altar of unhewn stones to offer sacrifices to God.
