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Rabbi Tzvi Bar-David: Shacharit and Torah reader

Shabbat Shuvah, the Sabbath of Return, lands in the liminal space between Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Today, Parashat Ha'azinu reminds us that teshuvah is a matter of deep listening—to the cosmic song of our covenant, to our history, and to each other. Classically, there are two types of return — *teshuva*: *teshuva m'yirah* and *teshuva m'ahava*: Returning out of fear and returning out of love. Returning out of love is considered the higher path; but sometimes we have to work through our fears before we can enter into love. Ultimately teshuva is the process of repairing our relationships: withing ourselves, with one another and with God.
